# What a plumbing, heating and air-conditioning systems mechanic does

They install water and air systems, fit and connect sanitary equipment, commission boilers and heat pumps, install smart-home systems and advise customers.

## Install

Lay pipes and ducts, fit sanitary ware, heating and ventilation in homes and buildings.

## Commission

Connect boilers and heat pumps, adjust the system and explain its use to the customer.

## Maintain

Inspect, service and repair systems, with on-call duty at times.

### This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you like understanding how a technical installation works
- ✓ you are handy at bending, welding and assembling pipes
- ✓ you are comfortable explaining a solution to a customer
- ✓ you like alternating between workshop, building site and customers' homes

### Less suitable if...

- you are afraid of heights on ladders and scaffolding
- you dislike on-call duty and urgent repair calls
- you find it hard to carry heavy components

## A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:30 Start of shift and orders** : Prepare the supplies, re-read the work order and load the service vehicle.
- 08:30 Cutting and bending pipes** : Cut, bend and join copper or steel pipes according to the system diagram.
- 10:30 Fitting a sanitary unit** : Fit a shower or a washbasin, connect the water and check that it is watertight.
- 13:00 Connecting the heating** : Fix the pipes, fit the insulation and connect a radiator or a boiler.
- 15:00 Commissioning and tests** : Adjust the system, measure the values and check that everything works properly.
- 16:30 Explaining to the customer** : Show how the system works, hand over the instructions and tidy the workstation.

## Exams and qualification

The final exam (Abschluss- or Gesellenprüfung) has two parts: part 1 takes place before the end of the second year and counts for 30 per cent of the result; part 2, at the end of the training, covers the customer order, planning, system analysis and maintenance, and business and social studies. Certificate issued by the HWK or the IHK depending on the company.

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The job calls for dexterity, physical fitness to carry heavy components, and ease on ladders and scaffolding; on-call duty is possible.

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
