What a bank clerk does

They welcome and advise a bank's customers, manage accounts and payments, assess loan applications and offer savings, protection and financing solutions.

Advise

Support customers with their accounts, savings, investments and protection needs, depending on their situation.

Finance

Assess a consumer, mortgage or business loan application and check the customer's creditworthiness.

Manage

Open accounts, process transfers and payments, and follow legal rules and internal procedures.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you like dealing with customers and can explain things simply
- ✓ you are comfortable with numbers and calculation
- ✓ you are careful with money and with rules to follow
- ✓ you enjoy learning about law, economics and financial products

Less suitable if...

- you do not like office work or customer-facing desk work
- you struggle with strict rules and written procedures
- you do not want to talk about money and contracts with customers

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 08:00 Opening and briefing for the day** : The trainer presents the appointments, the current files and the rules to follow.
- 09:00 Welcoming a customer** : Understand the request, open or change an account, explain fees and payment methods.
- 10:30 Following payment operations** : Check transfers, direct debits and standing orders, and spot anomalies.
- 13:00 Preparing a loan file** : Gather supporting documents and assess the customer's repayment capacity with the adviser.
- 15:00 Simulated advisory meeting** : Practise presenting a savings or protection solution suited to a customer profile.
- 16:30 Documentation and checks** : File the case and check compliance with legal rules and internal procedures.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Exams and qualification

The final exam is in two parts (gestreckte Abschlussprüfung). Part 1, in the 4th half-year, covers accounts and financing purchases (90 minutes, 20% of the mark). Part 2, at the end of training, has three written papers and a simulated advisory meeting. You obtain the IHK final certificate (Abschlusszeugnis IHK) as a bank clerk, issued by the Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The job is mostly sedentary, in a branch or an office, with daytime hours and weekend work being rather rare.

Documents to prepare

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

STRAIGHT AWAY

Customer adviser

Work in a branch on accounts, savings and loans, or in the bank's internal departments.

WITH EXPERIENCE

Bankfachwirt (IHK)

Further qualification at bachelor level, open after 2 years of practice, leading to more responsibility.

LONGER TERM

Bankbetriebswirt or studies

Continue with the Bankbetriebswirt or with business or economics studies, depending on your path.
