What a professional driver does

They drive lorries or coaches, check their vehicle before departure, secure the load or welcome passengers, and follow road rules in Germany and abroad.

Check

Check the engine, brakes and general condition of the vehicle before each departure, then after the trip.

Load and secure

Spread the weight of the load, fasten it properly and check the transport documents.

Drive

Drive a heavy goods vehicle or coach safely, following traffic rules and protecting the environment.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you enjoy driving and can stay focused on the road
- ✓ you are reliable and respect rules and schedules
- ✓ you can cope with working alone for long hours
- ✓ you like dealing with customers or passengers

Less suitable if...

- you dislike sitting for long periods of time
- you want fixed working hours that never change
- you handle delivery deadline pressure badly

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 06:00 Vehicle check** : Checking the engine, brakes, tyres and documents before leaving the depot.
- 07:00 Loading and securing** : The goods are spread across the lorry and then secured with straps.
- 08:30 Departure and driving** : The route is planned around traffic, breaks and the driving rules.
- 11:30 Compulsory break** : Rest time is respected and recorded under the social rules for road transport.
- 13:00 Delivery to the customer** : Unloading, handing over documents and a courteous exchange with the recipient.
- 16:00 Return and report** : Post-trip check, reporting any faults and entering the day's paperwork.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company		1-2 days school
Year 1 Vehicle and safety - How vehicles work and are checked - Traffic rules - Loading basics	Year 2 Transport and road - Load securing and weight distribution - Route planning - Intermediate exam	Year 3 Independence - International traffic rules - Dealing with customers - Final exam

Exams and qualification

An intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung) before the end of the 2nd year, covering the first 18 months. The final exam has a practical part of up to 5 hours in total (driving a heavy vehicle, vehicle checks, preparing a transport) and three written papers. You obtain the Abschlusszeugnis of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry (IHK).

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The job means long periods seated at the wheel, plus loading and securing movements. Driving safely calls for alertness and good physical condition.

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
