What a bookbinder does

A bookbinder designs bound products in one-off or industrial production: they repair books, make special orders and, in production, run the machines and control the work steps.

Bind by hand

Make products using manual binding and casing-in techniques, for special orders.

Repair and restore

Repair damaged books and work carefully on the finishing or restoration of volumes.

Produce by machine

In industrial production, set up and run machines and control the production steps.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you work carefully and have an eye for detail
- ✓ you have manual skill and dexterity
- ✓ you have a sense of aesthetics for decorating a book
- ✓ you accept the responsibility of working on precious books

Less suitable if...

- you dislike meticulous work that takes patience
- you are looking for a job that is purely office-based
- you do not want to work in a workshop or a production hall

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:30 Reading the orders** : The trainer allocates the day's jobs: bindings to make and books to repair.
- 08:30 Setting up the workstation** : Prepare the materials, work out the quantities needed and set up the tools and machines required.
- 09:30 Making a volume** : Assemble and bind a volume using manual or machine binding techniques.
- 11:30 Repairing a damaged book** : Carefully restore the cover or spine of a damaged book.
- 14:00 Decoration and finishing** : Add gilding, edging or a decoration to a product for a customer.
- 15:30 Checking and tidying** : Check the quality of the finished work, document the steps and tidy the workstation.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

Basics of the trade

- Planning and organising work
- Preparing stations, tools, machines
- First bound products

Year 2

Binding techniques

- Making by hand and by machine
- Choosing processing techniques
- Intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung)

Year 3

Chosen options

- Two options, e.g. book repair
- One-off or machine production
- Final exam (Gesellenprüfung)

Exams and qualification

An intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung) takes place before the end of the second year: written work planning and making a test piece. The final exam (Gesellenprüfung) has a practical task with a technical discussion, two written papers and a paper on economics and society. You obtain the Gesellenbrief (journeyman's certificate), issued by the Chamber of Crafts (HWK).

Pay

You are paid during the training. Throughout the training.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work takes place mostly in workshops or production halls; it demands a lot of care, manual skill and precision, especially for finishing and restoration.

Documents to prepare

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

Skilled bookbinder

Work in a print shop with a bindery, in print finishing or in a publishing house.

Specialise in creative product design with the Gestalter (crafts designer) qualification.

Work towards the Meister (master craftsman), antiquarian book restoration or a business management course.
