You analyse and make substances in a laboratory: a 3.5-year training, paid from the first year, alternating between the employer and vocational school.

What a chemical laboratory technician does

They test organic and inorganic substances, prepare mixtures, develop syntheses and analyse the results, which they record and evaluate on a computer.

Analyse

Test substances using chemical and physical methods, for example with a spectrometer.

Prepare

Make mixtures and preparations, separate and purify substances, optimise a synthesis.

Record

Note how each test went, evaluate measurements on a computer and follow safety rules.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you enjoy chemistry, physics and mathematics
- ✓ you watch closely for changes during an experiment
- ✓ you follow safety and environmental rules without exception
- ✓ you stay focused during long series of tests

Less suitable if...

- you struggle with chemicals, smells and fumes
- you have very sensitive skin or airways
- you are looking for an outdoor or very physical job

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 08:00 Instructions and planning** : The supervisor presents the day's tests; you plan the steps and get the equipment ready.
- 09:00 Preparing solutions** : Weigh, measure and prepare solutions, wearing a lab coat, safety glasses and gloves.
- 10:30 Synthesising a preparation** : Make a substance by following the steps, then separate and purify it.
- 13:00 Analysing a sample** : Measure the quality and quantity of a substance with an analytical instrument.
- 14:30 Record and evaluation** : Note the results and evaluate them on a computer using laboratory software.
- 16:00 Cleaning and safety** : Clean the instruments, put hazardous products away and follow the storage rules.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company			1-2 days school

Exams and qualification

The final exam (Abschlussprüfung) has 2 parts held at different times. Part 1 (35% of the mark) takes place before the end of the second year: 2 practical tasks on preparation and characterisation, then a written paper. Part 2 (65%) takes place at the end. You obtain the Abschlusszeugnis (final certificate) of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry (IHK).

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The job requires manual precision, good near vision and colour vision, and skin and airways that tolerate chemicals.

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

Skilled lab technician

Jobs in chemicals, pharmaceuticals, paints, food, cosmetics, institutes or environmental agencies.

WITH EXPERIENCE

Technician or master

Train as a technician (Techniker) in chemistry, laboratory technology, or as an Industriemeister (industrial master) in chemistry.

LONGER TERM

University studies

If university entry is met, study for example chemistry, biochemistry or chemical engineering.
