Dachdecker / Dachdeckerin

You cover, insulate and waterproof roofs and façades: a 3-year training, paid from the first year, for a trade that means working at height and in a team.

What a roofer does

They cover roofs and clad façades with tiles, slates or panels, make them watertight, fit insulation and install solar panels.

Cover

Lay tiles, slates, shingles or sheets on roofs and clad exterior walls.

Waterproof

Fit vapour barriers, insulation and waterproofing layers on roofs, balconies and terraces.

Equip

Install gutters, roof windows, lightning protection and solar panels on roofs.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you like working at height, outdoors and in a team
- ✓ you have good balance and no fear of heights
- ✓ you are handy and precise with roofing materials
- ✓ you are interested in insulation and solar energy

Less suitable if...

- you are afraid of heights or avoid ladders and scaffolding
- you cope badly with cold, heat or rain
- you find it hard to carry heavy loads

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:00** **Departure and safety briefing** : The team loads the materials and checks the scaffolding and the fall protection.
- 08:00** **Lifting the materials** : Bring tiles, insulation and tools up to the roof with the hoist and with the help of colleagues.
- 09:30** **Laying the roof covering** : Lay tiles or slates row by row on the roof, respecting the overlaps.
- 11:00** **Waterproofing and flashings** : Lay the waterproofing and make the flashings around a chimney or a roof window.
- 13:30** **Insulation and fittings** : Fit the insulation, fix a gutter or install a support for a solar panel.
- 15:30** **Checking and tidying up** : Check the watertightness, clean the roof and stow the equipment before coming down.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company		1-2 days school

Exams and qualification

An intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung) takes place at the latest at the end of the second year. The training ends with the journeyman's exam (Gesellenprüfung), whose main paper, roof, wall and waterproofing technology, counts for 60 per cent. You obtain the Gesellenbrief, issued by the Chamber of Crafts (HWK).

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The job calls for good physical fitness to carry materials, as well as balance, sure-footedness and a head for heights on ladders and scaffolding.

- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
