What a market and social research assistant does

They organise the preparation and running of market studies and social research projects: they gather information, code and check data and produce reports.

Prepare

Gather information on markets and target groups, and design questionnaires and interview guides.

Collect

Train interviewers, organise their work, enter questionnaires and check quality.

Analyse

Code data, check its consistency, process it with statistical software and write reports.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you like numbers, data and statistics
- ✓ you are accurate and can cope with precise work
- ✓ you like organising projects and teams
- ✓ you like reporting results to clients

Less suitable if...

- you do not want to work at a screen
- you dislike repetitive checking tasks
- you would rather do mostly manual work

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

08:30 Project update : Review the progress of current surveys with the team.

09:30 Questionnaire : Design clear questions for a questionnaire aimed at a specific target group.

11:00 Training interviewers : Explain how a survey works to interviewers and organise their rounds.

13:30 Data entry and coding : Enter questionnaire answers and code the open-ended responses.

15:00 Data checking : Look for inconsistent values and correct them with the project manager.

16:30 Results report : Turn a selection of results into charts for the client presentation.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

Reports and follow-up

- Analysis and presentation

Exams and qualification

A written intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung) of up to 120 minutes takes place in the middle of the second year. The final exam has three written papers (functions and methods, 120 minutes; research projects, 150 minutes; economics and social studies, 60 minutes) and a discussion of up to 20 minutes. Qualification: IHK certificate (Chamber of Commerce and Industry).

Pay

You are paid during the training. Throughout the training.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work is mostly in offices and meeting or training rooms, at a screen. Working from home is possible depending on the employer.

Documents to prepare

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
