What a protection and security specialist does

They plan and apply security measures, analyse risks, monitor equipment and rules, and step in calmly and lawfully when an incident occurs.

Monitor and protect

Carry out patrols, control access and monitor sites, with or without video surveillance.

Prevent risks

Assess hazards, check alarms, fire protection and locks, and act within the law.

Advise and plan

Present a security concept to a customer, plan teams and write reports.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you stay alert and observant for long periods
- ✓ you keep your cool and can defuse a conflict
- ✓ you accept shift work and on-call duty
- ✓ you follow rules and the law strictly

Less suitable if...

- you cannot provide a certificate of good conduct (criminal record)
- you refuse shift, night or outdoor work in all weathers
- you cope badly with tense situations or conflict

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:00 Start of shift** : Receive the instructions of the previous team and check the control equipment.
- 08:00 Access control** : Open and close gates, check entries and report anything unusual.
- 10:30 Control patrol** : Walk the site and check alarms, emergency exits and security installations.
- 13:00 Control room** : Watch the cameras and alarm systems and record observations.
- 15:00 Tense situation** : Stay calm with an agitated person and apply de-escalation techniques.
- 16:30 Report and client discussion** : Write the day's report and talk to the client about the site's security.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Exams and qualification

The final exam is split into two parts (Abschlussprüfung). The first, at the end of the 2nd year, counts for 40 %: behaviour in situations and legal basics. The second, for 60 %, covers economics and society, a written security concept and a simulated client discussion. Qualification: IHK certificate.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ According to BERUFENET, you need good body control, quick decisions and fast reactions in dangerous situations. The work is done in teams, with on-call duty, often outdoors in all weathers.
