What a flat glass technologist does

A flat glass technologist makes glass panes for cars, windows or façades: they cut the glass, grind and polish the edges, then treat the surfaces while operating automatic production lines.

Cut and shape

Cut flat glass, grind and polish the edges, drill and make glass products.

Treat the glass

Toughen glass thermally, laminate it, then finish surfaces by sandblasting, printing or etching.

Operate and maintain

Run automatic cutting lines, check quality and keep the machines maintained.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you work carefully, for example when preparing templates
- ✓ you like setting up and controlling machines and plant
- ✓ you have the skill to grind and polish glass edges
- ✓ you stay careful with hand-held machines

Less suitable if...

- you do not want to work in a production hall
- you dislike mathematics and calculating process data
- you dislike handling fragile and sharp materials

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:00 Instructions and orders** : The trainer presents the day's orders and recalls the safety rules.
- 08:00 Receiving the glass** : Check the glass sheets received and store them correctly in the warehouse.
- 09:30 Cutting and edges** : Cut a pane by hand, then grind and polish the edges of the piece.
- 11:30 Automatic cutting** : Enter the process data and start an automatic cutting line.
- 13:30 Surface treatment** : Decorate a glass sheet by sandblasting or printing, according to the order.
- 15:00 Checking and maintenance** : Check the quality of the finished pieces and maintain the machine before leaving it.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

Flat glass basics

- Receiving, transporting, storing
- Planning and preparing work
- Manual cutting and edges

Year 2

Machines and surfaces

- Machine cutting and processing
- Decorating surfaces
- Part 1 of the final exam

Year 3

Joining and quality

- Joining glass panes
- Thermal treatment of glass
- Part 2 of the final exam

Exams and qualification

The final exam (Abschlussprüfung) has two parts. Part 1, at the end of the second year, covers manual flat glass work and finishing processes. Part 2, at the end of training, covers machine work, flat glass technology and economics and society. You obtain the final certificate from the Chamber of Commerce and Industry (IHK).

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work takes place mostly in production halls, with glass sheets and machines: it demands skill for grinding and polishing, and care with hand-held machines.

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

STRAIGHT AWAY

Skilled technologist

Work in companies that make and process flat glass, or in the finishing trades of construction.

WITH EXPERIENCE

Glass technician

Take a technician course, or train as a Glastechniker (state-certified glass technician).

LONGER TERM

Industriemeister, glass

Work towards the Industriemeister Glas (industrial master, glass) or, under conditions, engineering studies.
