What a photographer does

A photographer produces portraits, product or industrial photos from an image concept: they choose the equipment and lighting, take the shots, then retouch, enlarge or produce moving images.

Design

Devise an image concept for the client, and choose the camera, lens and type of lighting that suit it.

Shoot

Set up the light and photograph the subject, often in series: other lenses, angles or lighting.

Retouch

Process, retouch, enlarge or reproduce the images, and produce moving images where needed.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you are creative and have a sense of image composition
- ✓ you watch light and image details attentively
- ✓ you are interested in camera technology and new trends
- ✓ you like meeting a client's wishes

Less suitable if...

- you do not want to work in a studio or at changing shooting locations
- you dislike spending time retouching images on a computer
- you dislike dealing with clients

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 08:30 Client briefing** : Analyse a client's request and discuss the image concept with the studio team.
- 09:30 Preparing the equipment** : Choose the camera and lens, then set the lighting to suit the subject.
- 10:30 Shooting the subject** : Photograph a portrait or a product, varying the angles, lenses and lighting.
- 13:30 Selecting images** : Go through the series of photos and keep the best shots for the client.
- 14:30 Retouching on computer** : Correct the light, retouch and prepare the images for their final use.
- 16:30 Archiving and delivery** : Export and archive the files and prepare the images for handover to the client.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

Photography basics

- Client advice and image concepts
- Cameras and lighting
- First shoots

Year 2

Image and processing

- Image processing in software
- Narrative image series
- Intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung)

Year 3

Option and finishing

- One option, e.g. people, product
- Image output and archiving
- Final exam (Gesellenprüfung)

Exams and qualification

An intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung) takes place in the fourth half-year: a written part on planning and a practical shooting task with a technical discussion. The final exam (Gesellenprüfung) has five areas, including shooting people and objects, an option and economics and society. You obtain the Gesellenbrief, issued by the Chamber of Crafts (HWK).

Pay

You are paid during the training. Throughout the training.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work takes place in the studio or at varied locations, outdoors, in companies or in halls: you carry and set up equipment and stay attentive to the light.

Documents to prepare

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

STRAIGHT AWAY

Skilled photographer

Work in a photo studio, a press agency, a publishing house or an advertising agency.

WITH EXPERIENCE

Gestalter im Handwerk

Specialise with the Gestalter (crafts designer) qualification, for more creative projects.

LONGER TERM

Meister or university

Work towards the Meister (master craftsman), which also allows study without the general baccalaureate.
