What a gardener does

Depending on the specialism, they propagate and grow plants, trees or vegetables, or create gardens, parks and sports grounds, planting, paving and building walls and steps.

Grow

Propagate and grow plants, trees or vegetables; water, feed, prune and protect the crops.

Landscape

Create gardens, parks and sports grounds: plant, pave paths, build walls, steps and fences.

Advise and sell

Sell plants and products and advise customers on where to put plants and how to care for them.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you enjoy working outdoors, with plants and soil
- ✓ you have stamina and accept working on your knees or bent over
- ✓ you have a feel for colour and space to compose a planting scheme
- ✓ you are careful with machinery and plant treatment products

Less suitable if...

- you struggle with cold, rain, heat and pollen
- you are allergic to plants, dust or fertilisers
- you are looking for an office job or one without physical effort

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:00 Start of shift and site** : The trainer assigns the day's tasks and recalls the safety rules.
- 08:00 Preparing the ground** : Prepare the soil and substrates, using hand tools and sometimes a small machine.
- 10:00 Planting the greenery** : Plant shrubs, perennials and flowers following the planting plan.
- 12:30 Building or maintenance** : Pave a path, build a wall or prune and maintain existing plants.
- 14:30 Watering and protection** : Water and feed the plants and check for any damage or disease.
- 16:00 Cleaning and tidying** : Clean the tools and machines, tidy the site and note the work done.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

Basic training

- Soils, earths and substrates
- Plant knowledge and care
- Machines, tools, safety

Year 2

Your specialism

- Choice of 7 specialisms
- Techniques for the specialism
- Intermediate exam

Year 3

Mastery

- Complete jobs in the specialism
- Selling, advising or site work
- Final exam

Exams and qualification

An intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung) before the end of the second year: practical (3 tasks, up to 3 hours) and written (up to 90 minutes). The final exam in the chosen specialism: practical (5 tasks, up to 5 hours, explained orally) for 60% of the mark, then written and oral for 40%. The qualification is issued under the authority of the Chamber of Agriculture (Landwirtschaftskammer).

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The job requires strength and stamina, working outdoors in all weathers, often kneeling or bent over, and tolerance of dust, pollen and plant treatment products.

Documents to prepare

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

Skilled gardener

Jobs in the specialism: landscaping firms, municipal gardens or horticultural production.

WITH EXPERIENCE

Further training

Train further in horticulture or plant protection, or become a customer adviser in horticulture.

LONGER TERM

Take the Gärtnermeister (master gardener) exam or become a technician (Techniker), set up on your own or study horticulture.
