What a building cleaner does

They pick the right method for each surface and place: windows, floors, textiles, facades, sanitary areas. They use machines, dose products, follow hygiene rules and work safely.

Clean

Clean windows, floors, textiles and facades, in routine, interim or deep cleaning.

Care for surfaces

Protect, preserve and restore surfaces using the right products and machines.

Ensure hygiene

Disinfect in healthcare, kitchens or sanitary areas, and dispose of hazardous waste.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you are careful and like to see the result of your work
- ✓ you are dexterous and can handle machines
- ✓ you have a head for heights and work comfortably at height
- ✓ you accept working early in the morning or late in the evening

Less suitable if...

- you are afraid of heights or refuse to climb a ladder
- you cope badly with chemicals and their fumes
- you refuse to work very early, late in the evening or at night

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

06:00 Preparing the job : Load machines and products, read the job sheet and travel to the site.

07:00 Cleaning offices : Vacuum carpets, polish hard floors and clean the sanitary areas.

10:00 Cleaning windows : Clean a glass facade using a ladder or platform and the safety equipment.

12:30 Disinfection : Disinfect healthcare rooms following the hygiene rules, with suitable protection.

14:00 Deep cleaning a floor : Strip and restore a floor covering with a special machine.

15:30 Inspection and handover : Check the result, advise the client on upkeep and put the equipment away.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

Cleaning basics

- Safety, products, machines
- Setting up a workplace
- Maintenance cleaning

Year 2

Interim cleaning

- Windows, textiles, floors
- Working safely at height
- First part of the exam

Year 3

Hygiene and restoration

- Deep and outdoor cleaning
- Hygiene and disinfection
- Preserving surfaces

Exams and qualification

The journeyman's exam (Gesellenprüfung) is split into two parts. The first takes place in the 4th half-year: cleaning glass, textile and non-textile surfaces, with practical work and a written test. The second ends the training: deep and outdoor cleaning, hygiene, surface care, economics and society. Qualification: Gesellenbrief, under the authority of the Chamber of Crafts (HWK).

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ According to BERUFENET, you need good body control and a head for heights to work on ladders, scaffolding or work platforms. Work is often early in the morning, late in the evening or at night.

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
