What a glass apparatus maker does

A glass apparatus maker builds special apparatus from technical drawings: they heat glass tubes and rods, shape them, then fuse them together and check manufacturing tolerances.

Hot working

Heat glass tubes and rods, then bend, draw, cut or blow them into shape.

Cold working

Cut, grind, drill and mill semi-finished glass and blanks, then fuse the parts together.

Check and repair

Check tolerances and glass stress, repair and modify existing apparatus.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you work with great care on fragile pieces
- ✓ you have the skill to cut, grind or drill workpieces
- ✓ you have good spatial awareness for reading drawings
- ✓ you have a feel for technology to maintain tools and machines

Less suitable if...

- you do not want to work in a workshop with flames and hot pieces
- you dislike mathematics, physics and chemistry
- you are impatient and dislike meticulous work

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:30 Reading drawings** : Study the drawing of an apparatus and choose the glass and tools to use for the day's order.
- 08:30 Setting up the station** : Set up the workstation, adjust the burner and prepare the glass tubes needed.
- 09:30 Hot glass working** : Heat and bend glass tubes, then fuse them to form one part of the apparatus.
- 11:30 Cold working** : Cut, grind or drill semi-finished glass pieces with suitable tools.
- 13:30 Checking the apparatus** : Measure the dimensions, check the tolerances and inspect the glass stress.
- 15:30 Repair and notes** : Repair an existing piece, then note the steps carried out and tidy the station.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

Glass basics

- Sketches and production drawings
- Planning and preparing work
- Cutting glass, first hot work

Year 2

Glass techniques

- Hot working by hand and machine
- Cold working of glass parts
- Intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung)

Year 3

Complete apparatus

- Making glass apparatus
- Measuring, checking, repairing
- Final exam (Gesellenprüfung)

Exams and qualification

An intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung) takes place in the fourth half-year: two practical tasks with a technical discussion, and a written part on glass properties. The final exam has five areas, including making a test piece (a glass apparatus). You obtain the Gesellenbrief (HWK) or the final certificate (IHK), depending on the competent chamber.

Pay

You are paid during the training. Throughout the training.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work takes place in workshops or production halls, on fragile pieces: it demands skill, precise work and care when heating and cutting glass.

Documents to prepare

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

Where it can lead

STRAIGHT AWAY

Skilled apparatus maker

Work in a scientific glassware company, at a university or a research centre with a glass workshop.

WITH EXPERIENCE

More demanding work

Deepen a field: borosilicate glass, quartz glass or soft glass, depending on the company.

LONGER TERM

Meister or manager

Work towards the Meister (master craftsman) or a crafts business management course.
