You create gold jewellery or silver objects from a design: a 42-month training in a workshop and at a vocational school, with a choice between gold and silver smithing.

What a gold and silversmith does

They work precious metals by forging, casting and joining them, then polish and decorate the surface to produce a finished piece of jewellery or an object.

Design

Draw jewellery or objects, on their own or from a client's request, sometimes using software.

Make

Forge, cast, solder and join gold, silver and other metals, then set the stones.

Repair and finish

Polish, decorate surfaces, repair or rework pieces and advise clients.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you have manual dexterity and good hand-eye coordination
- ✓ you enjoy drawing and imagining precise shapes
- ✓ you are very careful and notice the smallest details
- ✓ you have a sense of aesthetics and creativity

Less suitable if...

- you dislike meticulous work that takes a lot of patience
- you cope badly with fine dust and some smells
- you want a job of broad movements, with no precision work

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 08:00 Designing a piece of jewellery** : Make sketches and a production drawing from a client's request.
- 09:30 Casting and shaping** : Melt the metal, cast it, forge it or draw it out to get the shape you want.
- 11:00 Joining by soldering** : Join the parts by soldering and fit the clasps with precision.
- 13:30 Setting the stones** : Choose the right mount and fix the stone in its metal seat.
- 15:00 Polishing and finishing** : Grind, polish or matt the surfaces until they have the look you want.
- 16:30 Repairs and advice** : Inspect a piece for repair and explain the work needed to the client.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

The basics of the trade

- Safety, tools, machines
- Sketches and production drawings
- Filing, drilling, bending, soldering

Year 2

Making techniques

- Casting, forging and joining
- Surface treatment
- Intermediate exam

Year 3

Your specialisation

- Gold: jewellery, chains, gem-setting
- Silver: objects and functional pieces
- Stone setting and repair

Year 4 (6 months)

Exam preparation

- Exam piece made to order
- Advice and quality
- Final exam

Exams and qualification

An intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung) in the fourth half-year, with a 7-hour task, then the final exam (Gesellen- or Abschlussprüfung): a piece of goldsmithing made in 32 hours with a professional discussion, technology, design and planning, economics and social studies. Qualification: Gesellenbrief (crafts) or IHK certificate, depending on the competent Chamber.

Pay

You are paid during the training. Throughout the training.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work is done at a well-lit bench, with fine dust and sometimes smells. Gloves, goggles, a work coat and sometimes a mask are worn, and shift work exists in industry.

Documents to prepare

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

Where it can lead

STRAIGHT AWAY

Qualified gold and silversmith

Work in a goldsmith's workshop, a jeweller's, the jewellery industry or a design studio.

WITH EXPERIENCE

Master goldsmith

Take the Meister (master craftsman) exam to run a workshop and train apprentices.

LONGER TERM

Studies or own workshop

With the required entry level, study jewellery design or open your own workshop or jeweller's.
