You engrave designs, lettering and tools on metal and other materials, by hand or by machine: a 3-year paid training, in a workshop and at a vocational school.

What an engraver does

They work mainly with metals, but also plastic, glass and porcelain: they engrave rings, plaques and stamping tools, by hand or by machine.

Design

Create patterns from a client's request or their own ideas, scan photos and rework files in CAD software.

Engrave

Engrave rings, plaques, stamps and embossing tools with a graver, a machine or a laser.

Finish and check

Matt, polish and colour surfaces and check the shape, colour and quality of the pieces.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you have manual dexterity and precise hand movements
- ✓ you enjoy drawing and creating patterns, letters and ornaments
- ✓ you are very careful and faithful to the drawings you are given
- ✓ you are comfortable with a computer and precision machines

Less suitable if...

- you cope badly with machine noise and fine dust
- you dislike work that demands intense concentration
- you want a job with no drawing or computer work

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 08:00 Reading the order** : Study the client's drawing or file and choose the engraving process.
- 09:00 Preparing the workpiece** : Face, drill or mount the piece to be engraved to the required accuracy.
- 10:30 Machine engraving** : Programme the engraving machine or laser to inscribe text and patterns.
- 13:00 Hand engraving with a graver** : Trace fine lines by hand on a flat or curved surface.
- 15:00 Surface finishing** : Matt, polish and colour the engravings for the result you want.
- 16:30 Checking and sharpening** : Inspect the finished piece and maintain or sharpen the engraving tools.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

The basics of the trade

- Technical drawing and CAD
- Metalworking: filing, drilling
- Safety and tool maintenance

Year 2

Engraving techniques

- Hand and machine engraving
- Finishing and decorating surfaces
- Part 1 of the exam

Year 3

Orders and tools

- Stamps and embossing tools
- Reliefs, coins and medals
- Part 2 of the exam

Exams and qualification

A journeyman's exam (Gesellenprüfung) in two parts. Part 1 in the middle of the second year: making a workpiece (7 hours). Part 2 at the end of the training: a customer order (60 hours), production technology, design, economics and social studies. Qualification: Gesellenbrief, issued by the Chamber of Crafts (HWK).

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work is done in a workshop, with machine noise, fine dust and sometimes smells. Gloves, goggles and an apron are worn depending on the task.

Documents to prepare

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

STRAIGHT AWAY

Qualified engraver

Work in an engraving workshop, at an industrial tool maker or in a same-day service.

WITH EXPERIENCE

Master engraver

Take the Meister (master craftsman) exam to run a workshop and train apprentices.

LONGER TERM

Studies or own workshop

With the required entry level, study fine arts or open your own engraving workshop.
