What a digitalisation management clerk does

They make information and knowledge available to gain economic benefit from digitalisation, and they manage the digitalisation of business processes at the operational level.

Analyse

Study a company's processes to spot what can be digitalised or improved.

Design

Develop digital solutions and business models suited to the company's needs.

Advise

Advise customers on IT solutions and put in place security and data protection.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you are interested in both IT and business
- ✓ you like analysing processes and suggesting improvements
- ✓ you can explain a digital solution to non-specialists
- ✓ you like working on projects with several people

Less suitable if...

- you mainly want to program with no customer contact
- you dislike administrative and commercial tasks
- you dislike presenting your work to others

08:30 Team meeting : The team reviews the digitalisation projects under way and the priorities.

09:30 Analysing a process : Describing the steps of a company process to find efficiency gains.

11:00 Choosing a solution : Comparing digital tools with a requesting department and advising on the best option.

13:30 Buying IT products : Requesting quotes for hardware or services and comparing the offers.

15:00 Security and data : Checking that security and data protection rules are followed.

16:30 Project presentation : Preparing to present the results to the team or a customer.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

Common foundations

- IT workstation
- Company processes
- Security and data protection

Year 2

Area of activity

- Advising customers
- Process analysis
- Part 1 of the final exam

Year 3

Professional project

- Company project on your own
- Presentation and discussion
- Part 2 of the final exam

Exams and qualification

There is no intermediate exam: the final exam is spread over two parts. Part 1 takes place in the 4th semester (a 90-minute written paper on an IT workstation). Part 2 includes a company project of up to 40 hours, with a presentation, and written papers. Qualification: the Abschlusszeugnis of the IHK.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work is mostly sedentary, at a screen, in an office or in meetings. No particular physical fitness is required.

- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
