You shape sheet metal for gutters, façades and ventilation: a paid training of three and a half years for a trade split between workshop and building site.

What a Klempner does

They make and fit gutter systems, window sills, façade cladding and sheet-metal ventilation ducts, both on building sites and in the workshop.

Shape

Cut, bend, fold and weld sheet metal and tubes to make roof-metalwork parts.

Fit

Install gutters and downpipes, roof and façade cladding, then seal them.

Install

Fit ventilation ducts, solar collectors and lightning protection systems.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you like working with metal and shaping parts precisely
- ✓ you are handy and comfortable with cutting and bending machines
- ✓ you are not afraid of heights on ladders and scaffolding
- ✓ you like alternating between workshop and outdoor sites

Less suitable if...

- you are afraid of heights or avoid them
- you cope badly with the noise of workshop machines
- you find it hard to carry heavy parts

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:00 Start of shift in the workshop** : Check the day's orders, prepare the metal sheets and put on ear protection.
- 08:00 Cutting and bending sheet metal** : Mark out, cut and then bend the sheet on the machine to obtain the required shape.
- 10:00 Welding and assembly** : Join the parts by welding, soldering or folding, then check the fit.
- 11:30 Loading and leaving for the site** : Load the finished parts and the tools for fitting on the roof or façade.
- 13:30 Fitting a gutter** : Fix the brackets and the gutter, connect the downpipe and check the water flow.
- 15:30 Checking and tidying up** : Check the seals of the joints, clean the site and put the equipment away.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the “dual system”. You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

The basics

- Workshop, tools and safety
- Cutting, bending and welding
- First simple parts

Year 2

Technique

- Gutters and cladding
- Fixing into masonry and timber
- Part 1 of the final exam

Year 3

Independence

- Ventilation and sealing
- Solar and lightning protection
- Sites run independently

Year 4 (6 months)

Finishing

- Complete jobs to order
- Preparing for the final exam
- Part 2 of the final exam

Exams and qualification

The journeyman's exam (Gesellenprüfung) has two parts: part 1 takes place before the end of the second year and counts for 30 per cent of the result; part 2, at the end of the training, covers a customer order, manufacturing, assembly and maintenance technology, and business and social studies. You obtain the journeyman's certificate (Gesellenbrief), issued by the Chamber of Crafts (HWK).

Pay

You are paid during the training. Throughout the training.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The job calls for good physical fitness and ease at height, since sheet metal is taken up ladders and scaffolding; in the workshop, machine noise calls for ear protection.

Documents to prepare

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
