What a car mechatronics technician does

They check and repair the mechanical, electronic, hydraulic and pneumatic systems of cars using measuring and diagnostic equipment, and increasingly work on electromobility.

Diagnose

Read error codes, measure and analyse engines, chassis systems and driver assistance systems.

Repair

Replace faulty parts, carry out repairs and change oil or brake fluid.

Inspect

Take test drives, check the vehicle meets legal requirements and measure exhaust emissions.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you like working out why a car breaks down and getting it working again
- ✓ you are careful, because brakes and safety systems depend on your work
- ✓ you are comfortable with tools, wiring diagrams and diagnostic equipment
- ✓ you enjoy dealing with workshop customers

Less suitable if...

- you cannot cope with workshop noise
- you refuse shift work or on-call duty
- you dislike constantly learning new technologies

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:30 Start of shift and job orders** : The trainer assigns the day's vehicles and reminds you of the workshop safety rules.
- 08:15 Reading the fault memory** : Connect the diagnostic device, read the error codes and note down the customer's comments.
- 09:30 Measurements on the system** : Measure voltages and pressures, compare them with reference values and identify the faulty component.
- 11:00 Replacing a part** : Remove the faulty part, fit the new one and tighten the bolts as specified.
- 13:30 Check before handover** : Take a test drive, check brakes and lights, then record the results of the inspection.
- 15:30 Report to the customer** : Explain the work done and the parts replaced, then complete the workshop file.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company			1-2 days school

Exams and qualification

The exam (Abschluss- or Gesellenprüfung) has two parts. Part 1, before the end of the second year, covers a service order (Serviceauftrag) and counts for 35% of the result. Part 2, at the end of training, includes a customer order, vehicle and maintenance technology, diagnostics and economics and social studies. Qualification: Gesellenbrief (HWK) or IHK final certificate.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work takes place in noisy workshops with protective equipment (gloves, goggles, safety shoes), sometimes in shifts or with on-call duty.

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

Skilled worker

Work in a repair workshop or for a vehicle manufacturer.

WITH EXPERIENCE

Master in vehicle technology

Take the Kraftfahrzeugtechnikermeister (master craftsman) exam to lead a team or run a workshop.

With university entrance qualification: a bachelor's in vehicle engineering; or set up your own workshop.
