You build foundations, walls and floors: a 3-year training, paid from the first year, that prepares you for a career in structural building work.

What a bricklayer does

They build the structural shell of buildings: foundations, walls and floors in masonry or concrete, then plaster, screeds and insulation depending on the site.

Build

Lay walls, fit prefabricated elements and build foundations, slabs and floors.

Pour concrete

Make formwork and reinforcement, prepare the concrete, pour it and compact it in the formwork.

Renovate

Plaster, lay screeds and insulation, spot damage to the building fabric and repair it.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you like working with your hands and seeing a structure take shape
- ✓ you are careful when measuring and aligning with precision
- ✓ you are comfortable working in a team to handle heavy elements
- ✓ you are happy to work outdoors, even in cold or rainy weather

Less suitable if...

- you cope badly with cold, heat or rain
- you find it hard to carry heavy loads
- you are looking for an office job

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:00 Start of shift on site** : The team leader assigns tasks, the plans are checked and everyone puts on a helmet and safety boots.
- 08:00 Marking out and measuring** : Dimensions from the plans are transferred to the floor and levels are checked before the wall goes up.
- 09:30 Building a wall** : Lay mortar and bricks course by course, checking the plumb and alignment of each row.
- 11:00 Formwork and reinforcement** : Assemble formwork, place the steel reinforcement, then prepare the concrete to be poured.
- 13:30 Plaster and finishing** : Apply plaster to a wall, fill the joints and fit insulation according to the instructions.
- 15:30 Checking and tidying up** : Check the finished work, clean the tools and make the site safe before leaving.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company		1-2 days school

Exams and qualification

The final exam (Gesellenprüfung) has two parts: part 1 takes place in the fourth half-year of training, so in the second year, and counts for 40 per cent of the result; part 2 closes the training. You obtain the journeyman's certificate (Gesellenbrief), issued by the competent chamber: HWK for crafts, IHK for industry.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The job calls for good physical fitness: carrying materials and working outdoors in cold, hot or rainy weather on changing building sites.

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
