What an audiovisual media designer does

They prepare the production, shoot pictures and sound with the team, including live, then edit the material to make reports, videos or programmes.

Prepare

Research, develop concepts, draw up production documents and plan team, costs and deadlines.

Shoot and record

Set up cameras, lighting and microphones, then capture pictures and sound, sometimes live.

Edit and deliver

Edit, mix, add effects, graphics and titles, then archive the data.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you are creative and have a feel for pictures and sound
- ✓ you have technical logic and enjoy learning
- ✓ you can stay focused on a screen for a long time
- ✓ you enjoy teamwork with precise deadlines

Less suitable if...

- you cope badly with long periods at a screen
- you dislike working outdoors in all weathers
- you dislike workplaces that change often

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 08:30 Production meeting** : Read the concept, share out the team's roles and check the shooting schedule.
- 09:30 Setting up the equipment** : Choose and connect cameras, microphones and cables, then check that everything works.
- 11:00 Shooting and recording sound** : Frame the pictures, set the lighting and record clean sound with the team.
- 14:00 Importing and sorting footage** : Import the files, convert them, sort them and discard unusable takes.
- 15:00 Editing and effects** : Edit the sequence, add effects, graphics and titles, and mix the sound.
- 16:30 Archiving and delivery** : Save the project data and supply the finished product in the right format.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 2

Producing and editing

- Recording and post-production
- Complete audiovisual products
- Intermediate exam

Year 3

Options and project

- Two specialisation options
- Copyright and data

Exams and qualification

An intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung) in the fourth half-year, then the final exam (Abschlussprüfung): producing a picture and sound product (24 hours), specialisation options, picture and sound production, economics and social studies. Qualification: the IHK final certificate (Abschlusszeugnis) from the Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work combines screen time in production rooms with varied shooting locations, sometimes outdoors in all weathers. It calls for dexterity and concentration.

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
