You make and install gates, facades, canopies and structures in steel or light metal: a paid 42-month training in a craft business, with vocational school.

What a metal construction worker does

They mark out, cut, shape and join metal parts, often as one-off pieces to the customer's wishes, then install them on site and maintain their work.

Fabricate

Mark out sheets, tubes and profiles, cut and shape them, then weld, rivet or bolt the parts together.

Install

Fit doors, facades, locking and security systems on site, or drives for sun-protection systems.

Maintain

Check the structures made, adjust them and restore them when necessary.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you enjoy manual work and seeing a structure take shape
- ✓ you can read drawings and picture volumes in space
- ✓ you are physically fit and have a head for heights
- ✓ you accept working on building sites in all weathers

Less suitable if...

- you struggle with noise and carrying heavy loads
- you are afraid of heights and refuse to work on scaffolding
- you do not want to travel for an assembly job

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:00 Start of shift and instructions** : The trainer assigns the jobs and reminds you of the protective equipment to wear.
- 07:30 Reading the drawing and marking out** : Transfer the dimensions from the technical drawing onto the sheet or profile before cutting.
- 09:00 Cutting and shaping** : Cut the parts by machine or by hand, then bend or curve them to the required shape.
- 11:00 Assembly by welding** : Weld or bolt the elements together, wearing welding goggles and shield, and check dimensions.
- 13:30 Surface protection** : Treat the parts against corrosion before they leave for the building site.
- 15:00 Installation on site** : Fix an element to the building with the team, following the rules for working at height.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

Exams and qualification

The journeyman's exam (Gesellenprüfung) has two parts. Part 1, before the end of the second year, is a work assignment (Arbeitsauftrag). Part 2, at the end of training, depends on the chosen specialisation: for example a customer order, construction technology and functional analysis, economics and social studies. You obtain the Gesellenbrief from the Chamber of Crafts (HWK).

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ Good physical fitness is expected: lifting heavy parts, a head for heights to work on scaffolding, workshop noise and building sites in all weathers.

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

Journeyman metalworker

Work in a metal construction business or in a building trade such as facade construction.

Master metal construction worker

Take the Metallbauermeister (master craftsman) exam to lead a team or a business.

With university entrance qualification: a bachelor's in construction engineering; or set up your own metalwork business.
