What a technical product designer does

They design machines, plant or products to the customer's wishes, create 3D models, choose materials and standard parts, then produce drawings, parts lists and assembly plans.

Design

Use CAD to create precise models of machines, plant or products, following standards.

Dimension

Choose materials and standard parts, calculate and plan for economical manufacturing.

Document

Produce drawings, parts lists and assembly plans, manage versions and back up the data.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you like drawing, building and picturing objects in three dimensions
- ✓ you are precise and careful in your drawings and calculations
- ✓ you want to understand how machines work
- ✓ you like working at a screen, in contact with customers and workshops

Less suitable if...

- you do not want to spend the day at a screen
- you dislike calculations and the rigour of standards
- you mainly want manual work in a workshop

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 08:00 Meeting with the design team** : Review current projects, change requests and the priorities of the day.
- 08:45 Freehand sketching** : Sketch a part by hand to clarify an idea before moving on to modelling.
- 10:00 Modelling the part in 3D CAD** : Build the part in 3D, taking into account the material and how it will be manufactured.
- 13:00 Calculations and choosing components** : Calculate the forces, select standard parts and check that the solution is economical.
- 14:30 Drawings and parts lists** : Produce the manufacturing drawing, parts list and assembly plan to send to the workshop.
- 16:00 Managing versions** : Save the new version of the model, update the documents and back up the data.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

Exams and qualification

The final exam (Abschlussprüfung) has two parts. Part 1, towards the end of the second year, covers technical documents. Part 2, at the end of training, comprises a work assignment, development and design, then economics and social studies. You obtain the IHK final certificate from the Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The work is mainly screen-based in offices, with visits to production halls where machine noise is present.

- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
