You grow vines, make the wine in the cellar and sell it: a 3-year training, paid from the first year, on a wine estate.

What a winegrower does

They handle the whole wine production process: soil work, pruning and tending vines, harvest, pressing, fermentation, bottling, then sales and customer advice.

Grow the vines

Work the soil, plant, prune the vines, control weeds and pests, and harvest the grapes.

Make the wine

Press the grapes, monitor and steer fermentation, and look after the quality of the wine.

Sell

Bottle, label and pack the wine, advise customers and run tastings for visitors.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you like working in the vineyard, outdoors
- ✓ you are meticulous when pruning and tending vines
- ✓ you are interested in fermentation and wine chemistry
- ✓ you enjoy advising customers and running tastings

Less suitable if...

- you dislike working outdoors with the seasons
- you dislike technology and machine maintenance
- you refuse to handle crop treatment products

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:00 Work in the vineyard** : Prune or tie the vines and check the health of the vines, depending on the season.
- 09:30 Working the soil** : Maintain the vineyard soil and control weeds using the appropriate machines.
- 11:00 Checking the must** : Take and analyse a must sample, then note the results in the cellar log.
- 13:30 Work in the cellar** : Monitor fermentation, rack and treat the wine while following hygiene rules.
- 15:00 Bottling the wine** : Fill, label and pack bottles from the tanks or barrels.
- 16:30 Advice and tasting** : Run a tasting and advise a customer on the estate's wines.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company		1-2 days school

Exams and qualification

An intermediate exam (Zwischenprüfung) takes place before the end of the 2nd year: 3 practical tasks (up to 3 hours) with a discussion, and a 90-minute written paper. The final exam has a practical part of up to 7 hours (grapes, cellar, sales) and 3 written papers of 120, 120 and 90 minutes. The certificate is issued under the authority of the Chamber of Agriculture (Landwirtschaftskammer).

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ BERUFENET highlights dexterity, care and technical sense; the work is mostly done outdoors in the vineyards and in wine cellars.

- ✓ CV and cover letter in German
- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate

Qualified winegrower

Jobs on a wine estate, in a winery or in a winegrowers' cooperative.

WITH EXPERIENCE

Vineyard or cellar specialist

Take responsibility for one area of the estate, the vineyard or the cellar.

Master winegrower (Meister)

Take the Winzermeister or the Weinküfermeister (master cooper) to run an estate.
