You build roof frames, timber houses and staircases: a 3-year training, paid from the first year, for working with wood on building sites.

What a carpenter does

They build and erect roof trusses, timber houses and timber halls, make staircases, windows and partitions, protect the wood and renovate old structures.

Roof framing

Make and erect roof frames, dormers and timber frames from the plans.

Timber building

Make and assemble frame walls, solid timber elements and façade cladding.

Renovation

Replace damaged timbers, protect the wood and restore historic structures.

This occupation is for you if...

- ✓ you like working with wood and assembling large structures
- ✓ you have an eye for detail and manual precision
- ✓ you are not afraid of heights on a roof or a frame
- ✓ you like putting up structures as a team with colleagues

Less suitable if...

- you are afraid of heights or avoid them
- you find it hard to lift heavy beams
- you are looking for an office job

A TYPICAL DAY IN THE WORKSHOP

- 07:00** **Departure and safety briefing** : The team loads the materials, safety rules are recalled and everyone puts on a helmet and gloves.
- 08:00** **Reading the roof framing plan** : Identify the parts to cut and assemble, then take measurements on the timber.
- 09:30** **Cutting and machining timber** : Saw, plane and prepare beams in the workshop or on site with the right machines.
- 11:00** **Assembling a frame** : Join timber parts and erect a frame wall or a section of roof structure.
- 13:30** **Fitting insulation and cladding** : Install the insulation, ventilate the façade and fix the cladding following the instructions.
- 15:30** **Checking and tidying up** : Check the joints, clean the tools and store the offcuts of timber.

How the Ausbildung works

In Germany you learn by working: this is the "dual system". You are an employee of a company and a student at a vocational school (Berufsschule) at the same time.

3 to 4 days a week at the company

1-2 days school

Year 1

The basics

- Site, tools and safety
- Reading plans and measuring
- Basic woodworking

Year 2

Practice

- Frames and roof elements
- Insulation and cladding
- Part 1 of the final exam

Year 3

The trade

- Roof frames and timber structures
- Renovation and wood protection
- Part 2 of the final exam

Exams and qualification

The final exam (Gesellenprüfung) has two parts: part 1 takes place in the fourth half-year of training, so in the second year, and counts for 40 per cent of the result; part 2 closes the training. You obtain the journeyman's certificate (Gesellenbrief), issued by the competent chamber: HWK for crafts, IHK for industry.

What you need to apply

- ✓ Baccalaureate level is required.
- ✓ The required level is B2. Good technical vocabulary for the trade is a real plus.
- ✓ The job calls for good physical fitness to lift beams and heavy elements, and a head for heights to work at height.

- ✓ Translated baccalaureate diplomas and transcripts
- ✓ German B2 level certificate
